TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will continue a 3-game series against the Minnesota Twins in the Metrodome at 4:10PM ET... Lost last series/homestand to Texas (dropped 2 of 3) in Progressive Field and won series in Chicago last weekend... Finished last 6-game homestand against the Tigers and Twins at 4-2... Indians completed a 9-game roadtrip at 6-3 to Toronto, Seattle and Anaheim that included a season-high 5-game winning streak... Indians are 14-12 in the 2nd half, including a mark of 8-5 on the road in the 2nd half... Finished last trip to Chicago and Detroit at 2-4, losing 2 of 3 over each stop... Tribe is 24-34 on the road, 25-32 at home and their 0-5 start to the season was their worst in 24 years (1985, 0-5)... **Worst record at the break (35-54) since 1991 (26-53)**... The Indians were swept in a 3-game set in Texas Rangers Ballpark to begin the season... On Saturday, April 18 Indians scored a club-record tying 14 runs in the 2nd inning, the most runs ever scored in MLB history in the 2nd inning (ELIAS) and most ever all'd by the Yankees in a 22-4 win... Last time a Major League team scored 14R in any inning was 6/27/03 (Red Sox did it vs. FLA)... The 50 total bases tied the club record set on 7/16/04 at Seattle... The 8 extra base hits in the 2nd inning were a modern day record (since 1900) for EB hits in any inning and the 13 hits set or tied the club record... 25 hits were their most since recording 26 hits in a 10-9, 17-inning win on 5/7/95 vs. Minnesota (most in a 9.0IP since 1952)... Allowed 12 runs in the 6th inning at Boston before recording an out on May 7 (tied modern MLB record)... **Lost a season-high 6 straight games, 6/15-21, and went 5-13 in interleague play (Indians are 21-31 since 6/13, but have won 13 of their last 22 games since July 21 (13-9, .591))**

GATOR BAIT: Columbus 1B/OF MATT LaPORTA went 4-for-4 last night w/2HR, 2RBI & 3RS vs. Indianapolis... He has hit in 7 of his last 8 games, going 13-for-29 (.448) w/4HR & 11RBI in the process... On the year he is hitting .306 (100-327) w/23 2B, 17HR & 60RBI in 89 games... He is 8th in the league in avg, 4th in on-base % (.387), 3rd in SLG (.544) and 2nd in OPS (.931) to Andy Marte's .963.

NO LAFFEY MATTER: Indians LHP AARON LAFFEY is 5-2 w/a 3.17 ERA in 10 starts this year (59.2IP, 58H, 21ER, 28BB, 30K) and is 3-1 w/a 1.40 ERA over his last 4 starts (25.2IP, 22H, 4ER)... His season ERA of 3.25 would rank 8th in the AL with the required ## of innings pitched (is 40.0IP short)

IN SEARCH OF: The Indians have no homered in their last 4 games (37.0IP), have just 5HR in 12 August games and 3HR in their last 10 games (6HR in last 14G since 7/29)... Have not HRd in last 6 games in Progressive Field... Indians are now 10th in the AL in HR (122) and 8th in slugging % (.423).

HE GROWS ON YOU: Since July 1 INF LUIS VALBUENA is hitting .302 (.26-86) with 7 2B, 1 3B, 1HR & 7RBI in 24 games (15RS)... Over the span he has a slugging % of .465/an OPS of .820... On year his season OPS is .703

CHAPMAN ANNIVERSARY: Tomorrow is the 89th anniversary of the only on field death in MLB history... On August 16, 1920 Indians SS Ray Chapman was hit in the head with a pitch in the fifth inning by New York's Carl Mays. Chapman suffered a fractured skull and died the next day.

MAHONING STARS: The Mahoning Valley Scrappers, owners of the best record (34-19) in the New York-Penn League, have placed five players on the NYPL All-Star team... All 5 selections are draft picks from strong 2008 and 2009 draft classes by the Indians... The 5 All-Stars are INF KYLE SMITH (14th round '09), OF JORDAN HENRY (7th round '09), RHP COREY BURNS (8th round '09), RHP MARTY POPHAM (20th, 2008) & RHP CLAYTON COOK (9th, '08)... TRAVIS FRYMAN will manage the NYPL AL squad... Henry is leading the league in on-base % (.415), Popham is T2nd in K (59) and Cook is 8th in ERA (2.06).

PRICE LINE: Newly acquired RHP BRYAN PRICE (6.0IP, 5H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 2K) last night pitched well for the 3rd straight start since joining the organization on July 31 from Boston in a 6-4 A Kinston win at Salem... He is now 2-0 w/a 1.50 ERA in 3 starts (18.0IP, 16H, 3ER, 3BB, 11K, .242avg)

DID YOU KNOW?

Indians have won 7 of their last 13 and 13 of their last 22 games... Have won 5 of their last 7 series... Are 8-5 on the road in the 2nd half... Have won 3 straight series vs. the top 3 teams in the AL Central

The Indians pitching staff has an ERA of 4.08 (236.0IP, 236H, 107ER) in the 2nd half, which ranks 4TH best among AL pitching staffs after the All-Star break.

The bullpen ERA over the last 5 games is 3.86 (16.1IP, 17H, 7ER)

ASDRUBAL CABRERA is batting .310 on the year which ranks 15th in the AL in average.

SHIN SOO CHOO ranks 4th in the AL in on-base percentage (.398) and 10th in the league in walks (64)...

TRAVIS HAFNER is now 11th in the Indians all-time HR list w/157... Keltner is 10th w/ 163... HAFNER has an OPS of .845.

Indians have used 48 players this year (28 pitchers, 20 position players)

Indians have been hit by a pitch 69 times most in MLB... SHOPPACH has been hit 16 times which leads the Majors (Choo is 3rd w/13)

ERIC WEDGE is now in 5th place in club history with 545 managerial wins.

Indians are 45-24 when scoring 4 or more runs and 4-42 when scoring 3 or fewer.

ASDRUBAL BRINGING "A" GAME: SS ASDRUBAL CABRERA is having a terrific season batting .310 w/60RS, 5HR & 46RBI despite missing over 3 weeks w/a left shoulder injury... His 46RBI are 1 shy of his career-high (47 in '09)... Over his last 31G since July 8th he is batting .331 (43-130) w/12 2B, 2 3B, 3HR & 13RBI (.892 ops)... Cabrera has hit safely in 20 of his last 22G batting .340 (33-97) w/16RS, 9 2B, 2 3B, 3HR & 10RBI... His .310 avg currently ranks 15th in the AL in average.

SECOND HALF PICKUP: The Indians pitching staff has an ERA of 4.08 (236.0IP, 236H, 107ER) in the 2nd half (only 77BB in 236IP, 2.93 BB/9.0IP)... **The 4.08 ERA ranks 4th best in the AL in the 2nd half... Indians are hitting .276 (249-901) in the 2nd half with 127 runs scored in 26 games (.349OB/.430SLG, 4.9RS/GM)... Indians are 14-12 in the 2nd half... Despite their 49-66 record, the Indians offense currently ranks 7th in the Majors in runs scored with 578 (5.03RS/G) and are on pace to score 814 runs this year... Indians hit .260 in the first half w/451RS in 89G (.345ob/.420slg)**

LAST GAME: The Indians fell to Texas, 4-1, in the rubbein the Metrodome as SCOTT BAKER (CG/SHO, 9.0IP, 2H, 0R) dominated the Indians as the Twins pounded loser JUSTIN MASTERSON (3.1IP, 6H, 7R), JESS TODD (0.2IP, 2ER) & TOMO OHKA (3.0IP, 2ER) on 12 hits... JASON KUBEL (3H, 5RBI, HR) & JOE MAUER (3-3, 2RS, 2RBI) each had 3 hits...

LHP DAVID HUFF (6-6, 6.72ERA)

DAVID HUFF... Is making his 17th start of his Major League career today vs. the Minnesota Twins in the Metrodome ...It is his 10th career start on the road and his 3rd start vs. the Twins... **Selected by Cleveland in the "Sandwich" round (39th overall) between the 1st/2nd rounds of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of UCLA...**

⇒He was 7-4 with a 2.98 ERA (129.2IP, 121H, 50R/43ER, 27BB, 100K) in 16 starts for the Bruins during his junior year of 2006, tossing 3 complete games...Named to the PAC-10 All Conference First Team

⇒In 2007 was named to the Carolina League all-star team, going 4-2 w/a 2.72 ERA in 11 starts (59.2IP, 57H, 18ER, 15BB, 46K, 4HR)...Last start came on 5/31...Missed the last 3 months of the season w/a left elbow strain.

LAST YEAR ... In 2008 David enjoyed a breakout year between Akron and Buffalo, putting together a combined 11-5 record with a 2.52ERA (146.1IP, 112H, 41ER, 13HR, 29BB, 143K, .210 AVG) in 27G/26GS... For the year he led all Indians minor league pitchers in ERA, was T4th in wins and was 2nd in strikeouts and innings pitched...His combined .210 average against between Akron and Buffalo was the 11th lowest mark among ALL full season minor league pitchers...Following the season he was named the 6th best prospect in the International League by **Baseball America**.

⇒Began the season at AA Akron and won his last 5 decisions from April 20-May 31...Promoted to Buffalo on June 1...Over his last 9 outings at Akron his ERA was 1.11 (57.0IP, 33H, 7ER) and worked at least 5.0IP in all 9 games...Promoted to Buffalo where he dominated hitters as he went 6-4 w/a 3.01 ERA (80.2IP, 68H, 27ER, 8HR, 15BB, 81K) in 16 starts... Held batters to a .224 (68-303) average at Buffalo...Over his last 9 starts at Buffalo he was 4-2 w/a 2.32 ERA (42.2IP, 34H, 11ER)...Combined on the year he went at least 5.0IP in 23 of his 27 starts

⇒Entered 2008 as the 8th best prospect in the system by **Baseball America**...Also enters 2009 as the 9th best prospect in the Indians organization according to **Baseball America**.

THIS YEAR/SPRING... So far this year at AAA Columbus David is 5-1 w/a 4.35 ERA in 7 starts (39.IP, 35H, 19ER, 5HR, 16BB, 32K, 241AVG)...At the time of his May 17 promotion he was T1st in the International League in wins...This spring limited to 2 outings (4.0IP, 8H, 4R/ER) due to left shoulder tendinitis and was re-assigned to minor league camp on March 19

⇒Went at least 5.0IP in all 7 of his starts and fanned a season-high 7 on April 25 vs. Indy...IL hitters are batting .241 (35-145) w/5HR allowed...LHH are batting .275 (11-40) w/1HR and RHH are batting .229 (24-105) with 4HR allowed...Batters are batting .283 (15-53) with runners on base and .281 (9-32) with RISP....Tossed 6.0 shutout IP on May 1 vs. Durham.

⇒ Made his Major League debut on May 17 as his contract was purchased that day from AAA Columbus...Fell to 0-1 in the 7-5 Tampa win... 3.2IP, 7H, 7R/ER, 4BB, 2K... Did not get a decision in his start of Saturday, May 23 in Cincinnati, a 7-6 comeback win over the Reds and David Weathers...3.0IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 1BB, 3K, 3HR to Hernandez & Votto (2HR)...Tossed season-high 4.0IP in start of May 28 (4.0IP, 4H, 0R) vs. TB, but did not get a decision thanks to a 2:40 rain delay in the 5th inning of an eventual 2-1 win... Fell to 0-2 after his start on Tuesday, June 2 against the Minnesota Twins in the HHH Metrodome, a 4-3 loss to the Twins despite tossing a career-high 5.0 innings... 5.0IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 0BB, 5K, HR to Mauer...Threw 98 pitches/64 strikes.

⇒Picked up his first Major League win in his last start of Sunday, June 7 in Chicago, an 8-4 win over the Sox and Colon...5.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 3BB, 3K, HR to A Ramirez...**Notched 2nd straight win in start vs. STL on June 12 (career-high 7.1IP, 6H, 3R/ER)...Worked a career-high 8.0IP shutout innings in start of June 23 at PIT (9.0IP, 4H, 0R, 2BB, 2K)... The 3 straight wins equals an Indians individual season-high... Fell to 3-3 in start vs. CIN on June 28 (5.0IP, 6ER) ... Earned his 4th win of the season on July 3, a 15-3 victory over the Oakland Athletics in Progressive Field... 6.0IP, 8H, 3R/ER, BB, 4K...Worked into the 8th inning and won his 5th game at Toronto on July 23 (7.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER) and worked into the 8th inning in loss at LA Angels (7.0+IP, 8H, 5R/ER) on July 28...Suffered his 6th loss of the season as he dropped his 2nd consecutive start on August 4 vs. the Minnesota Twins in Progressive Field... Was a 10-1 loss to the Twins and Scott Baker... 4.2IP, 11H, 7R/ER, BB, 4K... **Over his last 12 starts since June 7th he is 6-4 w/a 6.07 ERA (71.1IP, 89H, 48ER)...Over last 7 starts he is 3-4 w/a 7.63ERA (46.0IP, 70H, 39ER).****

⇒ Thru 16 starts batters are hitting .315 (116-368) w/15HR, including a .284 (69-243, 9HR) by RHH and a .376 (47-125, 6HR) mark vs. LHH...Batters are hitting .287 (48-167) with runners on base and .344 (32-93) with RISP... Has 4SB against/1CS...Indians are averaging 5.53RS/GM in his 17GS (94R)...Indians are 9-7 in his starts.

LAST START ... Got the win in his last start of August 9 at Chicago, an 8-4 win over the Sox and Jose Contreras...6.1IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 1K, 2HR (Pierzynski/Ramirez)... 92 Pitches.

ON THE ROAD ... Today is David's 10th start/app. on the road this year/career... **THIS YEAR/CAREER:** He is 4-3 w/a 7.20 ERA in 9 starts (50.0IP, 66H, 40ER, 17BB, 22K).

TUESDAY'S STARTER: LHP AARON LAFFEY will make his 11th start/17th appearance of the 2009 season vs. the Minnesota Twins in the Metrodome...Improved to 6-3 in his last start of August 11 vs. the Texas Rangers in Progressive Field, a 5-0 win over the Twins and Dustin Nippert... 6.2IP, 6H, 0R, 3BB, 2K... Indians **LHP AARON LAFFEY** is 5-2 w/a 3.17 ERA in 10 starts this year (59.2IP, 58H, 21ER, 28BB, 30K) and is 3-1 w/a 1.40 ERA over his last 4 starts (25.2IP, 22H, 4ER)...Suffered a right oblique strain on May 22nd at Cincinnati and was placed on the DL until being activated on July 8 at Chicago-AL... Made 4 rehab starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus going 0-1 with a 6.91 ERA (14.1IP, 21H, 11R/ER, 10BB, 9K) most recently starting on July 3 for Columbus (L, 4.0IP, 10H, 7ER)... **This year with the Indians is 6-3-1 with a 3.25 ERA (72.0IP, 69H, 26ER, 32BB, 39K) in 16 games/10 starts...** Laffey began the 2009 season at AAA Columbus making 1 start before being recalled on April 15th... He made 4 starts with the Indians going 2-0 w/a 4.09 ERA (22.0IP, 21H, 10ER, 15BB, 10K) before being moved to the bullpen on May 6th... As a reliever he was 1-1 with 1 save and a 3.65 ERA (12.1IP, 11H, 5ER, 4BB, 9K) in 6 appearances...Is 2-0 w/a 1.26 ERA in 2 starts vs. the Twins this year and career he is 3-1 w/a 3.89 ERA in 6 starts (34.2IP, 33H, 15ER)
